

## JOINT WVCG AND RSA RE-ENACTMENT SATURDAY 21ST SEPTEMBER 2013

Maps showing how to get to the Cromer Campsite. ("X "MARKS THE SPOT) For the 1944 France combat event with the RSA group. MAP ONE shows the roads coming from Gumeracha and Birdwood Roads. MAP TWO is a blown up version showing how to get there. You should have no problems if you follow the arrows and details on the map. When you turn onto Cromer Road it is just a short distance to the gate on the left, (will be sign posted) into the Mt Crawford Forest Campsite. Go through the gate and follow the road to the campsite. Remember you can camp overnight and enjoy the after battle get together with a Schnapps or two.

It is important that the members of the WVCG get to know the RSA guys as we are looking at supplying our vehicles in future joint club events. These types of re-enactments give the WVCG members the opportunity to show off their vehicles and use them as they were originally intended to be used.

The RSA group really go for authenticity and it will be an experience to see how Axis and Allied troops looked and fought during WW2. So please try and get to the events and enjoy using our vehicles and enjoy ourselves. If you have weapons that can be fixed to your vehicles bring them along and use them.
